The following code is developed in C#:

```
//import the Mail Interface  
using System.Net.Mail;
```

```
protected void sendMail()
```

//create the mail message
```

```
MailMessage mail = new MailMessage();
```

```
//set the addresses
```

```
mail.From = new MailAddress(txtEmail.Text.Trim());
```

```
mail.To.Add("recipient@recipientAddress.com");
```

```
//set the content
```

```
mail.Subject = txtSubject.Text.ToString();
```

```
mail.Body = txtQuestion.Text.ToString();
```

```
//send the message
```

```
SmtplibClient smtp = new SmtplibClient("localhost");
```

```
smtp.Credentials = new NetworkCredential("yourAccount@yourDomain.com", "your_password");
```

```
smtp.Send(mail);
```

```

```

Please note that you need to use localhost as the SMTP detail as there is no remote connection made between your site and our mail server.
